I earned my Ph.D in the subject of Veterinary Obstetrics and Gynecology from Rajasthan Agricultural University Bikaner in 2001 after receiving MVSc (1985) in Veterinary Obstetrics and Gynecology from MLS University in continuation of Bachelors degree in 1983 from the University of Udaipur. I started my career as a junior research fellow in Indian council of Agricultural Research Magra sheep scheme and then joined the Rajasthan Cooperative Dairy Federation in 1985 with work on cattle, buffaloes and camels. I was responsible for various activities like treatment, extension work and running the diagnostic lab and AI centers. In 1995, I was on deputation to the District rural development Agency as an Assistant Project Officer and was responsible for implementation of the various government development works for the rural people. In 1996, I was selected as an Assistant Gynecologist in the Rajasthan Agricultural University where I worked for improvement of buffalo reproduction. I was shifted to the Bikaner Veterinary College for teaching and research and promoted to the post of Associate Professor. In this Institute I gained plenty of exposure in teaching and working with diverse species including camels. I have guided 14 MVSc and two Ph.D scholars for their research.

I and my students as well, received various research awards for outstanding research work. I have also published 106 papers in International and regional journals and have to my credit publication of 7 books, the most recent one to be published from Lambert Academic Publishers Germany on the title Domestic Animal Obstetrics. The citations of our publications have been exceptionally good. I have acted as a referee to many international journals and also Assistant/Associate Editor many journals. I have attended many conferences and have been invited to deliver key note addresses and guest lectures at many places. I have also organized and attended many infertility camps and farmers training and symposia.

Our focus of camel research has been enhancing reproduction in camel and camel obstetrics. I have acted as an Assistant Editor to Journal of Camel Practice and Research for a couple of years. I have recently worked as a reproduction consultant for camels at Bin-Hamoodah Agricultural Premises Al-Ain UAE.
